

BRIEF OVERVIEW

Assessment based Project Management Qualifications Diploma of Project Management (BSB51407)

This nationally accredited qualification is gained through an assessment-based program, designed for Project Managers, and is carried out in the workplace, using evidence from the job.

The Diploma of Project Management is based on Level 5 of the National Competency Standards for Project Management and on the internationally accepted Project Management Body of Knowledge (Registered by the Project Management Institute, USA).

Each candidate in the Diploma program is linked with an experienced Workplace Assessor, Jeff Dutton (an accredited trainer with ICTE-UQ RTO and partner RTO The Learning Collaborative) who is also a practising Project Manager/mentor. This provides an opportunity for the candidate to learn through mentoring and to progressively meet the requirements of the Competency Standards, using current evidence.

It is possible for an experienced candidate to complete the qualification using the above strategies without the need for any extra training other than the continuing support/mentoring of the assessor.

The fee per candidate entering the assessment-based Diploma of Project Management qualification program is \$3200 (no GST applies) – all materials are included.
