# ENGLISH FOR ACADEMIC COMMUNICATION (EAC)

Semester 1 2010, UQ St Lucia

## About English for Academic Communication (EAC)

EAC is an eight week, part-time course provided at no additional cost to all UQ students from non-English speaking backgrounds who require assistance with their English language skills.

EAC is designed and delivered by The University of Queensland's Institute of Continuing & TESOL Education (ICTE-UQ).

## Course Content

EAC is divided into four streams of study.

Students choose one stream for the first four weeks of the course and then either continue with the same stream or choose a different stream for the second half of the course.

Stream 1	Writing for Academic Communication
Stream 2	Speaking for Academic Communication: Pronunciation and Vocabulary Workshop
Stream 3	Listening & Note-taking skills: Understanding Australian English
Stream 4	Reading Strategies & Grammar Workshop

EAC is delivered over a series of 2 hour classes. 16 hours of tuition is provided in the first half of the course and 8 hours is provided in the second half.

## Course Fee

No tuition fees are required for UQ undergraduate and postgraduate students (including study abroad and exchange) or research higher degree candidates from a non-English speaking background.
