UNDERSTANDING ENGLISH GRAMMAR

About Understanding English Grammar

Understanding English Grammar is designed and delivered by The University of Queensland's Institute of Continuing & TESOL Education (ICTE-UQ).

The course is designed for speakers of English as a first language and provides an introduction to some aspects of English grammar. It enables participants to develop their understanding of the form, meaning and function of the language they use.

Course Content

The course is practical with participants engaged in a range of interactive, discovery tasks. It will include some of the following:

- Verb forms and tenses
- Parts of speech
- Non-verb grammar (e.g. noun phrases, articles, prepositions)
- Text and genre analysis
- Phrasal verbs
- The grammar of vocabulary
- Modality

This non-award course has no formal assessment. Participants receive an ICTE-UQ Certificate of Attendance.
